

## COST OF OWNING AND KEEPING A DONKEY

Electric fencer	£100	
Plastic 3ft fencing stakes (based on 1 square acre that has solid fencing around the parameter) - 15 posts if field is square	£20	
Electric fencing tape - 200m roll	£20	
Internal batteries	£12	each
Stable wheelbarrow	£40	
Fork	£20	
Shovel	£15	
Yard broom	£10	
Poop scoop & rake	£15	
Head collar & rope	£8	
Grooming kit (Dandy brush, Body brush, Plastic Curry Comb, Hoof pick, tray/basket, cotton wool/sponges, scissors)	£15

**NB.** Costs are approximate and may vary from supplier to supplier and region to region. Other initial expense will depend on facilities already available such as shelter, fencing, hard standing area, electricity supply etc

Hay - if donkeys off grazing in winter - 1 bale per wk for 26 weeks. Prices vary from £1.50-£4.50 a bale.	£65	£39 - £117
Straw - feed & bedding @ £1/bale 100 bales per donkey per year. (Prices can range from £0.50-£3 depending on area)	£100	£50 - £300

\*The number of times per year that the donkey needs to be wormed, and which drug should be used, will depend on the owner/keepers land management system, other animals kept and results of a faecal count. Consultation with an equine veterinary surgeon is therefore strongly recommended.

**NB.** The above costs are approximate and are based on a healthy donkey that has a good body condition, has access to sufficient nutritional grazing during summer and is off the field in the winter with access to ad lib barley straw. Veterinary costs shown are only for annual checks and vaccinations. Please be aware that veterinary treatment for health problems can sometimes cost several hundreds of pounds.

Elderly donkeys, those with dental problems, donkeys that may need extra feed or those with respiratory problems, may require different bedding and/or feed which can often be more costly.
